Booina in the Southern Flinders Ranges of South Australia - April 21st 2011 until April 30th 2011.



Booina is a private farming property not open to the public and is located 250 kms north of Adelaide in South Australia.

Thursday April 21st 2011: It was approximately 8am when we left home for our first caravan break for some time. With different work commitments, our times away have been drastically reduced so the need to enjoy our break was a top priority to us.
