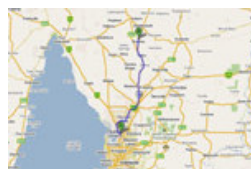

Riverton South Australia - May 13th 2011 until May 15th 2011.



Riverton can be found 83kms north of Adelaide in South Australia.

Friday 13th May 2011: It was 3:00pm when we received a phone call from Bruce & Maree to let us know that they were traveling along the Port Wakefield road heading out of town towards the new Northern Expressway on their way to Riverton. This was our signal to put the dogs in the Patrol and to start heading to Riverton ourselves.
