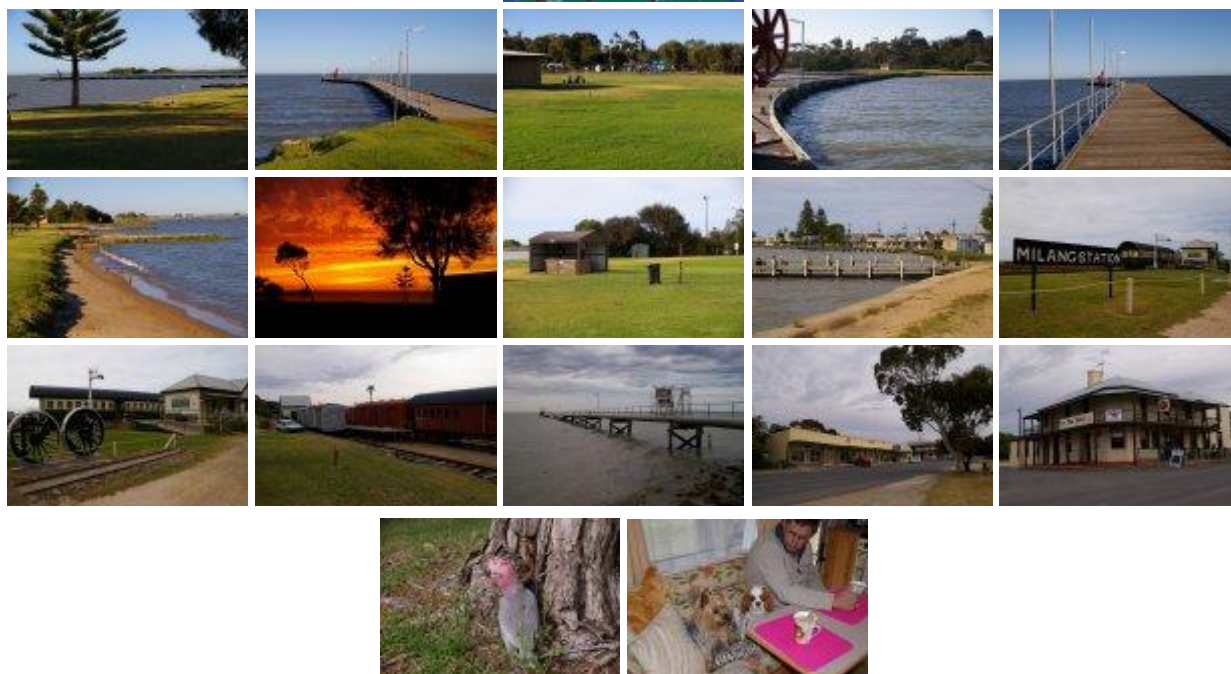


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## Milang -November 10th November 2006 until 13th November 2006.

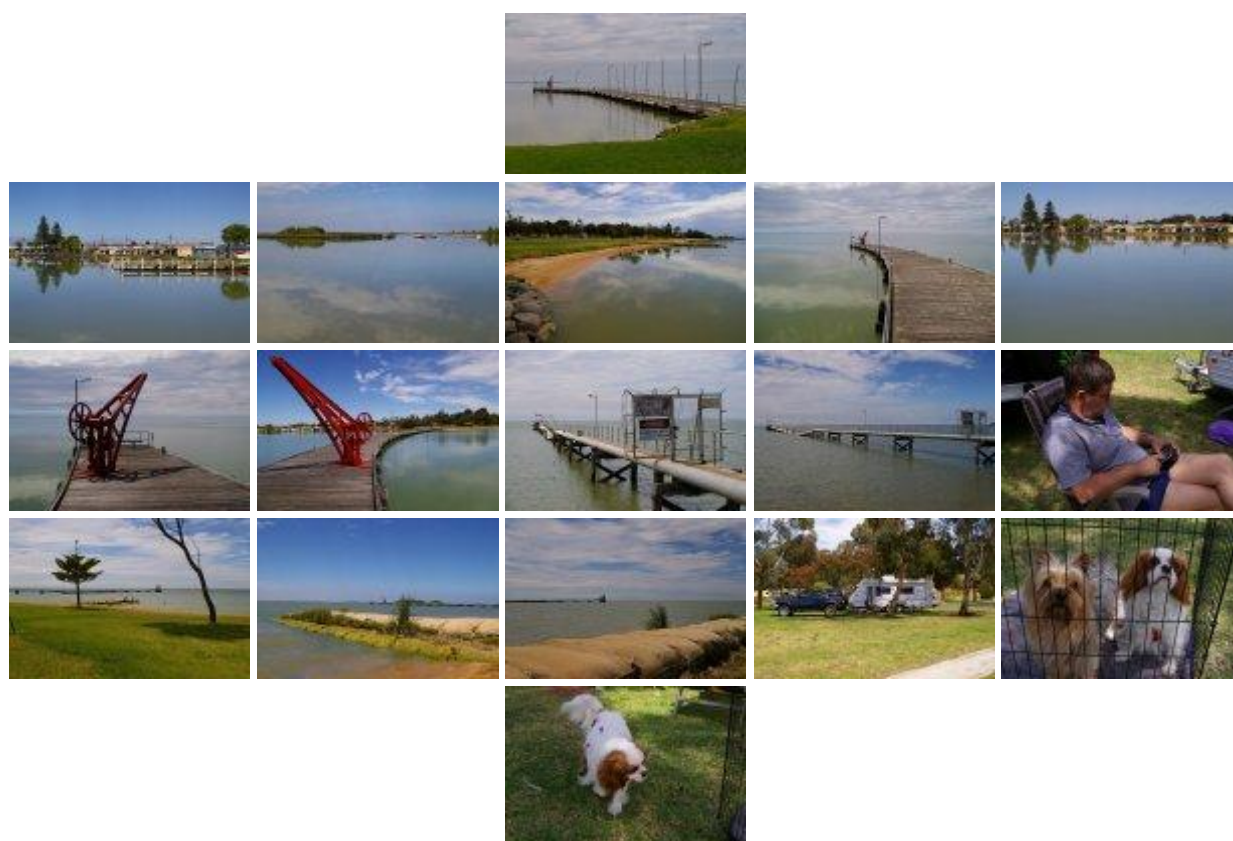
