

Just Cruisin with Mick and Sally

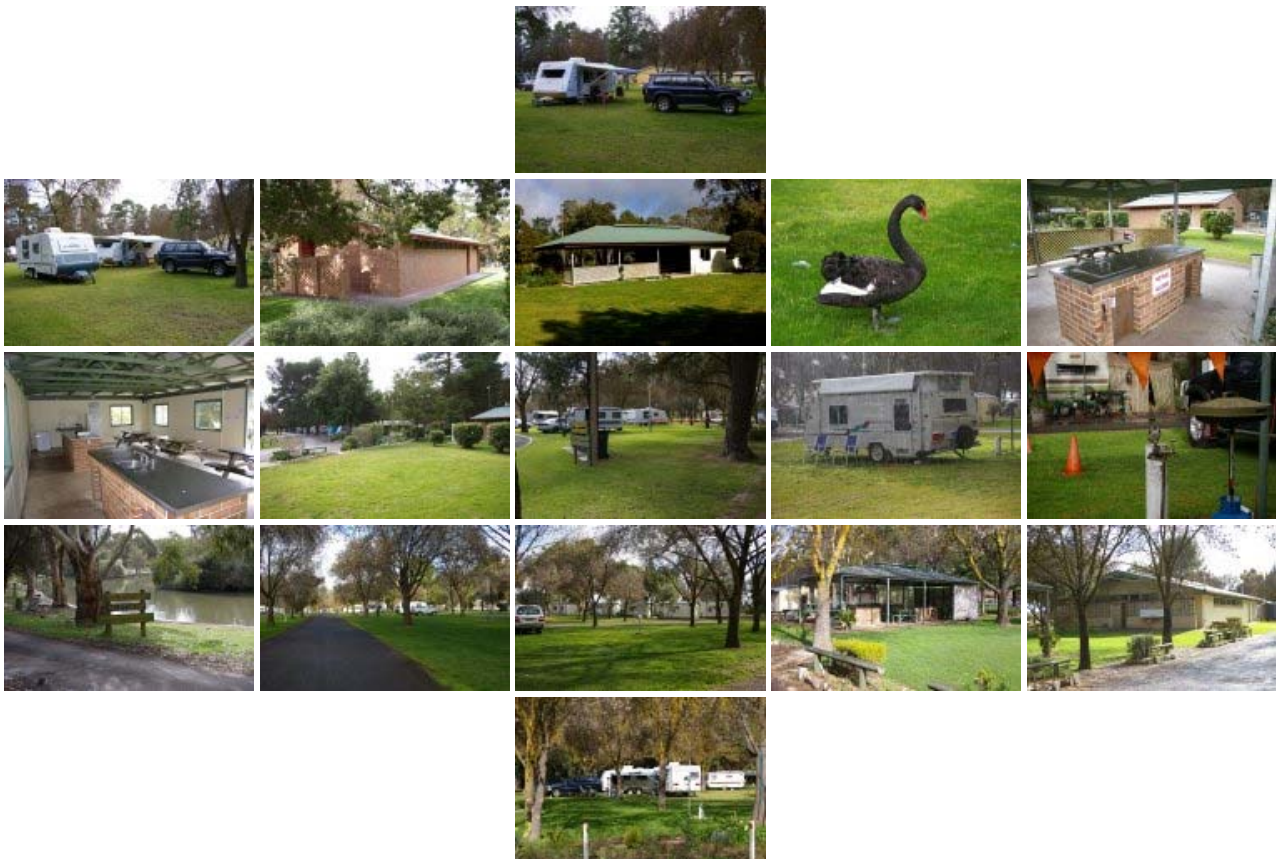

Nuriootpa South Australia - August 5th 2007 until August 7th 2007.

Nuriootpa is located 76 kms east of Adelaide South Australia in the Barossa Valley.

Fri 5th August 2007: It was a rush for me to do the final packing and to get the caravan hooked up before Sally arrived home from work as I had been into the city for an appointment earlier in the day. When Sally arrived home, I was still washing the dust off of the front of the caravan. Finally after everything was done, with the caravan in tow, we headed for Nuriootpa soon after 2.30pm.
