

Just Cruisin with Mick and Sally

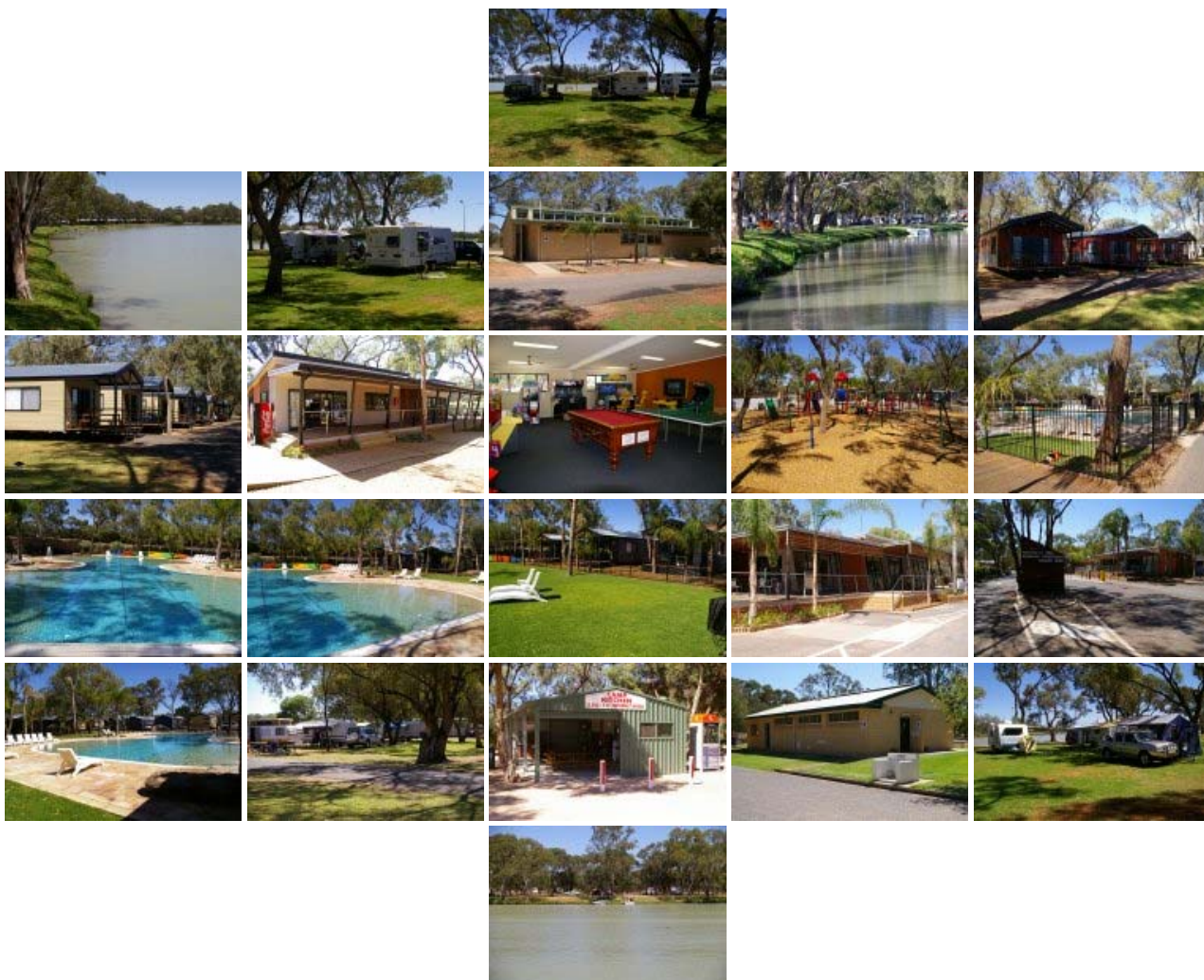
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Renmark South Australia - November 23rd 2007 until November 26th 2007.

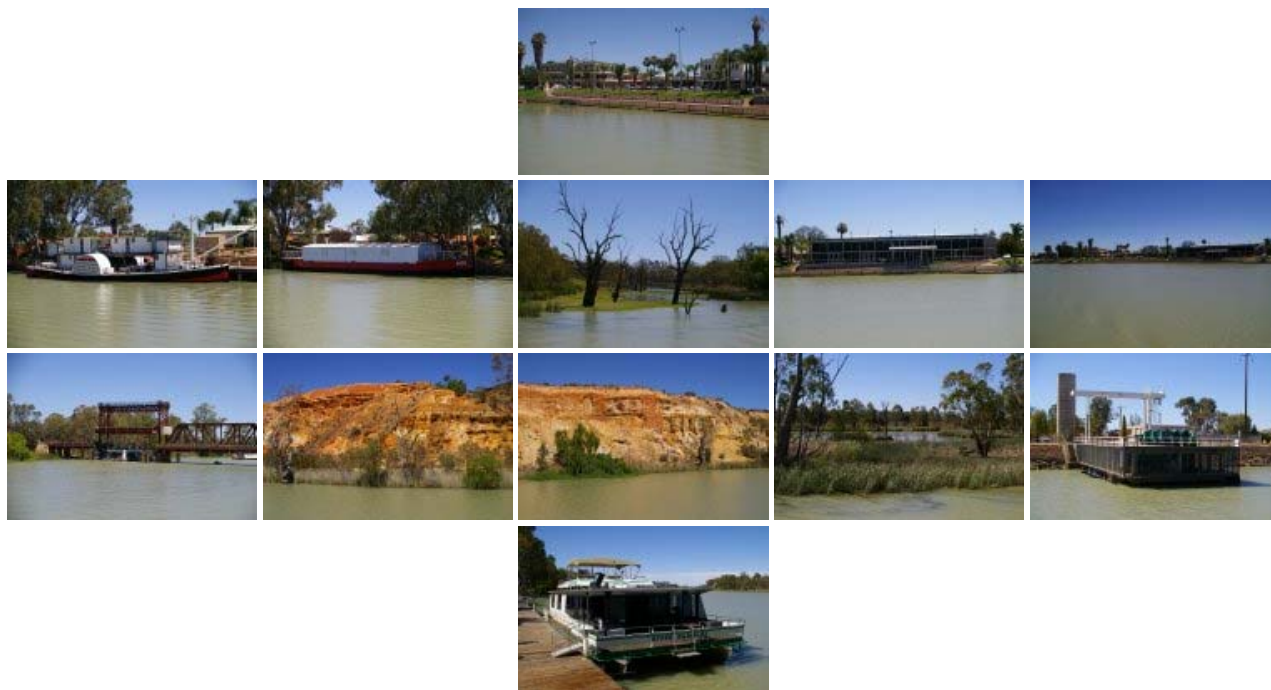
Renmark Riverfront Caravan Park is located in the Riverland at Renmark 256 km north east of Adelaide.
