Tanunda South Australia - March 7th until March 10th 2008.

Tanunda is situated 70 kms from Adelaide in the Barossa Valley.

Fri 7th March 2008: With Tanunda being only 70 kms from Adelaide, it was a short drive from home when we left at approximately 2.00pm. Friday wasn't as hot as it was during Saturday and Sunday, but it was still up there with the temperature reaching 38 degrees celsius. Bruce and Maree did not leave until late afternoon with them arriving at 7.00pm.

Sat 8th March 2008: Today's maximum temperature reached 40 degrees so it was off early to beat the heat while looking at the Angaston Farmers Market and a quick shop at Nuriootpa on the way home.
